Second, show competency

Enlist in the Military

Show evidence that you have signed a contract to enter a branch of the U.S. armed services upon graduation.

Earn credit for one college-level math and/or college-level English course through Ohio's free College Credit program.

Third, show readiness

Earn two of the following diploma seals, choosing those that line up with your goals and interests. These seals give you the chance to demonstrate academic, technical, and professional skills and knowledge that align to your passions, interests, and planned next steps after high school.

*At least one of the **two** must be Ohio-designed*



OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal*

Students must have 3 mentors in two of the following 3 environments: school, work, and/or community to validate the 15 professional skills



Seal of Biliteracy*

Attain a score of 5 on the AAPPL: an assessment of standards-based language learning across the three modes of communication: Interpersonal, Presentational, and Interpretive



Industry-Recognized Credential Seal*

This seal is earned when a license in one of the following "in-demand" professions is acquired through Maplewood: Auto Collision Technology, Automotive Service Excellence, Cosmetology, Dental Assisting, Machining, and Welding



Honors Diploma Seal*

Meet the criteria for 1 of 5 honors diplomas:

- Honors Diploma
- Career-Tech Honors Diploma
- STEM Honors Diploma
- Civics and Social Sciences
- Fine Arts Honors Diploma



College-Ready Seal*

Earn remediation-free scores on the ACT (18+ on English and mathematics and 22+ on reading) or SAT (480+ on Evidence-Based reading and writing and 530 on mathematics)



Technology Seal*

Advanced Placement credit; earn a "B" or higher in an approved College Credit Plus course; or complete a course offered through the student's school that meets guidelines set by the ODE



Military Enlistment Seal*

Providing evidence of enlistment in an armed services branch of the military; OR participating in an approved Junior Reserve Officer Training (JROTC) program



Community Service Seal

Following the guidelines adopted by Field Local's School Board, complete 80 hours of community service or a Passion Project



Citizenship Seal*

Proficient on American History and American Government End Of Course exam; Advanced Placement credit; earn a "B" or higher in approved College Credit Plus Courses



Student Engagement Seal

Following the guidelines adopted by Field Local's School Board, athletes, marching band and club members, and Passion Project participants are eligible to obtain this seal



Science Seal*

Proficient on the Biology End Of Course exam; Advanced Placement credit; earn a "B" or higher in approved College Credit Plus Courses



Fine and Performing Arts Seal

Following the guidelines adopted by Field Local's School Board, demonstrate skills in the fine or performing arts in drama, course work, achievement or a Passion Project
