Community Service Seal- Complete a community service project aligned with the guidelines adopted by the student’s local board of education or school governing authority.

Community Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 80 hours of community service attained over 4 years beginning with the Class of 2024 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Class of 2023 needs 60 hours ○ Class of 2022 needs 40 hours ○ Class of 2021 needs 20 hours ● Minimum of 10 hours per organization ● Hours need to be completed with a public or private organization (not with a family member) ● Hours can be obtained across activities (ie. NHS, TI, etc.) and during the school day, after school, or on the weekend ● If student transfers in, hours are adjusted by 20 hours per year (ie. students moves in during 10th grade year, he/she needs 60 hours) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Complete Log: date, time, duties, organization, supervisor sign off ■ Turn Community Service Log into Falcon Period Advisor ■ Deadline for completion is May 1
Community Service Passion Project	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Using the Passion Project Approval Form, propose an idea for a student-chosen project that benefits the community ● Once approval is obtained, complete passion project 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Turn in Passion Project Approval Form to guidance ■ Upon completion, documentation of project must be turned in to guidance ■ Deadline for completion is May 1



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Student Engagement Seal- Participate in extracurricular activities such as athletics, clubs or student government to a meaningful extent, as determined by guidelines adopted by the student’s local board of education or school governing authority.

*** During the course of the year, if the student becomes ineligible, the activity, sport, or club will not count towards a graduation seal. ***

Clubs (Spanish or French Club, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Quiz Bowl, Teen Institute, Ski Club, Creative Writing Team, or Student Council) Student Leadership Opportunity (Principal or Superintendent Advisory Member)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Student participates in 2 different clubs or 2 years of the same club with 80% attendance ● Student participates as a Student Advisory Member for 2 years with 80% attendance 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ The advisor will take attendance at each event ■ The principal’s and superintendent’s secretary will take attendance at each meeting
National Honor Society	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Student is inducted into the National Honor Society 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ The advisor will take attendance at each event and meeting
Big Red Mascot	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Student needs to attend 10 events in costume 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ The athletic director will document the number of events attended for each mascot
